More Things to Consider

Other factors to consider are exposure to the sun and the color of the fabric. A darker shade will allow a bit more transfer of solar heat gain into the home; however it will provide you with a better view-through. You can also modify the openness of the weave if you have a south west exposure – the tighter the weave, the better the heat control.
